The successful candidate will have the ability to inspire colleagues and, working in close collaboration with our Musical Director, further improve the creative standards of the orchestra.

Payment for this role is £800 per term.

About us

Established in 2009 and based in St Margaret's Church, Blackheath, London SE13 5DL, Harmony Sinfonia is a vibrant and thriving amateur orchestra playing a diverse and enterprising range of music. We perform three concerts a year, based on a seven-rehearsal termly schedule, with rehearsals held on Wednesdays, 7.45–10.00pm, plus a concert-day rehearsal on Saturday.

Application process

Those wishing to be considered should submit a CV (no longer than two sides of A4), with a covering letter outlining how they would fulfil this role. Candidates should also include a written reference(s) that will demonstrate their ability to fulfil this role, and a link to a video showing an example of their playing.
